Brian Simon ISCHE Postgraduate Bursary

The History of Education Society GB will offer one bursary to cover registration and standard class travel to the International Standing Conference for the History of Education (ISCHE). The bursary will be offered in open competition to a student registered for a masters or doctoral degree at a British University who is a member of the History of Education Society GB. Applicants should send an extended (circa 2,000 words) version of the proposal accepted by the ISCHE conference organising committee to the chair of the Bursary Competition by the closing date of the Bursary Competition (see schedule below). The proposal should be accompanied by proof of registration for a masters or doctoral degree at a British University on the closing date for Bursary applications and proof that the proposal has been accepted by the local committee organising the ISCHE Conference. All applications received by the closing date for the Bursary Competition will be judged by a panel convened by the Executive Committee of the History of Education Society. The History of Education Society reserves the right not to award a Bursary in any given year.

Criteria for award of the Bursary

1. Membership of the History of Education Society GB
2. Proof of registration for a masters or doctoral degree at a British University on the closing date for applications to the Bursary Competition
3. Proof that the associated proposal has been accepted by the local committee organising the ISCHE conference
4. Evidence within the extended proposal of
 - Location within appropriate secondary literature
 - Use of primary historical sources
 - Rigour of methodological approach
 - Potential to make an original contribution to the field of historical study

The bursary holder is expected to prepare and submit their paper for the special ISCHE conference edition of *Paedagogica Historica*.

Schedule for submitting to the History of Education Society GB Brian Simon ISCHE Postgraduate Bursary to be awarded for the ISCHE Conference 2007 in Hamburg

1. Authors will submit their proposal to the ISCHE conference by 31 December 2006
2. Authors will be notified by the ISCHE Conference Committee of the acceptance of their proposal for a paper by 31 March 2007.
3. Authors should prepare an extended 2000 word version of the proposal to reach the address below by the closing date of 2 May 2007
4. Outcomes of the Bursary Competition will be announced by 22 May 2007
5. The winner of the Bursary should register with the ISCHE Conference in time for the early bird registration (last date 31 May)
